WHO ARE WE SERVING AND WHY?

Spence-Chapin provides adoption and counseling services to women and families experiencing an unplanned pregnancy/birth. Our goal is threefold:



to provide 24/7 access to experienced social workers in underserved communities



to help women explore all their options related to parenting within a supportive and unbiased environment



to prevent children from entering the foster care system



Spence-Chapin offers limited respite care for infants, independent experienced attorneys, and reliable referrals to enable women and families to make considered and informed choices for themselves and their children absent long waiting lists and without involvement of the public system.

Spence-Chapin's birth/expectant parent program is privately funded, and all services provided are free.
